## DISCOVERERS

Pupils are developing their engagement in all areas of learning. In this learning Pathway, there is a strong focus on communicating effectively problem solving, self-regulation and social interaction skills.



### STEP:1 EARLY DISCOVERERS

Pupils are learning through Play to self-regulate and communicate. This supports pupils to engage with others and the world around them.

### STEP:2 DISCOVERERS

Pupils learn functional life skills taught with the support of therapeutic strategies. Pupils are developing communication, problem solving and social interactions skills to prepare them for life beyond school.
