

Home/School Agreement

The School will:

- Ensure your child's physical and social wellbeing at all times, and foster feelings of confidence, self-worth and belonging.
- Deliver a balanced and carefully planned curriculum.
- Ensure that any home learning tasks are relevant and meaningful, and that they reflect the learning needs of your child.
- Welcome parents/carers into the school community and ensure that teaching staff discuss any concerns you might have about your child's progress or general welfare.
- Keep you informed about school policies and guidelines linked to pupil progress, behaviour and equal opportunities, as well as more general school matters.
- Keep you regularly updated on relevant, meetings, events and information about school events.
- Inform you on a weekly basis regarding any specific information about your child progress and participation.
- Ensure that all teaching staff keep up to date on important educational developments and initiatives, which might affect your child.
- Assess the progress of your child and ensure they are on the correct curriculum pathway irrespective of the location of their learning.
- Provide information relating to school closures and other factors outside of the schools' control will be added to both Arbor and the website.

Parent / Carers will:

- Ensure that my child attends school regularly and that I notify school of any absences. Where there is an absence because of a medical appointment parents / carers are asked to provide the appointment letters.
- Ensure that my child arrives and, where appropriate is collected promptly at the beginning and end of the school day.
- Let the school know of any concerns or worries that may be affecting my child's learning, behaviour or ability to do home learning, so that support can be put in place.
- Understand that the school does not utilise home school diaries on a daily basis.
- Work with the school to ensure that all policies of the school are supported.
- Support my child's home learning and wherever possible, promote opportunities for home learning.
- Attend meetings with my child's teacher and other staff. Meetings will have a focus, aim to be productive and positive. Ensure that I/ we attend my child's Annual Review meeting and other meetings initiated by the school.
- Understand that my child will be placed in a class according to their individual need and age, either on the main school site or at a satellite location.
- Regularly read information on the school website or messages so that I am kept up to date with important details of relevant policies, meetings, events and information about my child.

- Ensure that their child is 'ready to learn' on arrival to school. This means that they will have had breakfast and that personal care and any medical treatment has been completed. If either of these present a challenge, they will discuss this with the school.

Pupils will:

- Follow the school motto - 'I am, I can, I will'.
- Always aim to do my best in all my lessons.
- Be polite and respectful towards others.
- Be positive and help other children to do the same.
- Always look after school equipment.
- Use or follow guidance to use the Winchelsea Zones and my Toolkit to help me to be ready to learn.
- To make 'Helpful Choices' for Learning throughout the school day and follow the expectations of the adults in school.
- Use social media responsibly and in accordance with the school's expectations.
